Having read the Petition of the Antrim County Board of Commissioners for a Determination of the Normal Height and Level of the Waters of Elk and Skegemog Lakes, and having heard testimony in support of said Petition, and the Court being further fully advised in the premises, now, therefore,

On Motion of Robert J. Stephan, Prosecuting Attorney for Antrim County, Michigan, on behalf of Petitioner,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED and this Court by virtue of the authority therein vested and in pursuance of the statute in such case made and provided, does ORDER AND ADJUDGE that a level of 590.80 feet Elk Rapids Dam gauge reading (588.26 feet International Great Lakes Datum of 1955) shall be maintained from April 15 of each year or ice break-up on said lakes, whichever occurs later, until November 1 of each year; on November 1 of each year said lake level shall be reduced to 590.20 feet Elk Rapids Dam gauge reading (587.66 International Great Lakes Datum of 1955) until the following April 15, or ice break-up, whichever occurs later at which time it shall be increased to the previous above stated level until further Order of this Court.
